Progress of our New Aumbry: Cathedrals and main churches have an 'Aumbry', a special chamber to store the Holy Oils that are used for Baptism, for Confirmation and for Anointing of the Sick. The design of the new Aumbry for St Michael's is inspired by the Holy Water fonts that are in the entrance lobbies to either side of the main entrance of St Michael's Church. It has been done by the Architect, Ciaran Mullarkey, of Mullarkey Pedersen Architects, Derry City. The work has been undertaken by Tracey Brothers. The stone work has been supplied by the Feely Stone Company and electrical work by Paul Keenan.
