## Reflection

St Peter and St Paul: It is an example of God's strong sense of humour that he picked St. Peter and St. Paul to build the foundations of the early Church. No mere human would have picked such unlikely candidates. St. Peter was an educated, peasant fisherman from a backwater Roman province who would go to the heart of Rome and become the first leader of a movement that is still the largest organization in the world over 2,000 years later. St. Paul was part of a strict sect of Judaism that insisted on following every letter of the Mosaic law who would eventually argue against the Church leadership to overturn much of the Mosaic law. St. Peter was the Rock-a man of action who had a history of backing out when things got tough prior to the Resurrection- yet he brought structure and stability to the early church. Tradition holds that St. Paul had a meek personality with a speech impediment but his ideas form a major part of the New Testament. Christ certainly chose an odd couple of start his Church.
