Reflection:

When we offer each other a sign of peace we are not so much making peace as accepting the gift of Christ's peace. When Mahatma Gandhi died he had just one picture in his room, of the Risen Christ and under it a quotation: "He is our Peace" (Eph2:14) This is a peace which our squabbling cannot destroy..To be a member of the Church is to share Christ's peace, however perturbed we may feel. Thomas Merton wrote in his journal: "We are already one. But we imagine we are not. And what we have to recover is our original unity. What we have to be is what we are." When we offer each other Christ's peace we are making up for more than a cross word. We are accepting the basis on which we are gathered together..We recognise that we are here in church not because we are friends or because we enjoy the chummy atmosphere or because we have the same theological opinions but because we are one in Christ's peace. What matters is not that we feel united, but that peace is given.
