Reflection (Richard Rohr)

Most of us think and act as if God is a God of retribution and even eternal punishment. But the Bible, Jesus, and the mystics of all the world religions reveal that God is infinite love, which really changes everything. Most religious people have put the cart before the horse by imagining that we can earn God's love by some kind of moral behaviour. Whereas, according to the saints and mystics, God's love must be experienced first--and then our moral behaviour is merely an outflowing from our contact with that infinite source toward all other people and things. Love is the powerful horse; morality is then the beautiful cart that it pulls, not the other way around. The passion of Pope Francis is to again make merciful love the foundation, the centre, and the goal of Christianity. Love is not just the basis on which we build everything, but it's also the energy with which we proceed, and it's then the final goal toward which we tend. Love has two lovely daughters, twins called grace and mercy. Like identical twins, they are often indistinguishable: Grace is the inner freedom to be merciful. Mercy is grace in action. And both are the children of love.
