Reflection

Who is God for us

The authors of the Old and New Testaments used illustrations from the created world to describe God. Here we encounter God as man and woman, as cloud, dove, eagle, fire, light, rock, wind and water. Other illustrations of God are taken from roles held in life. Roles such as mother, father, host, visitor and wrestler. Further illustrations depict God as the holder of various occupations such as gardener, potter, judge, king, landowner and shepherd. As we reflect on these images, it is important to note that no image teaches everything about God. Rather, the images in the Old and New Testaments are the images that God has chosen to reveal to Gods' people.
