Reflection on the Feast

Today we celebrate the dedication of **St John Lateran** historically the oldest church in Rome. It was the residence of the Pope for centuries before he moved to the Vatican. It remains his cathedral. It is considered the mother of all churches! Our Gospel for this feast recalls Jesus cleansing the Temple in Jerusalem. The theology of the Temple was such that to get to God you had to qualify culturally, socially and in terms of purity. The goods sold in the Temple markets were used in sacrifices so that people could meet the requirements to be closer to God. You can understand why Jesus was angry and challenged this model. He tells people early on in John's gospel that HE is God's Temple. God cannot be confined. Jesus words are too controversial for his listeners and challenging such important structures comes at a price. We gather as community in prayer and worship in our churches united with Christians all over the world, yet we remember it is the [people who gather there in Jesus' name who are the real church. The Temple of God is the Christian community, the Body of Christ with Jesus as its foundation
