### Reflection:

St. Paul always seems to write with great conviction. To me he comes across as one who has a very deep desire, almost a need, to bring the salvation of God to others.

He is a man who is 'driven', someone who burns with a passion to proclaim the Gospel and a person who works hard to ensure that the early followers of Christ are not taken away from the truths of the message of Jesus. It would appear from the letter to the Corinthians for this weekend that the people of Corinth are confused by other teachings that challenge discipleship in the Risen Christ and by those who deny the truth of the Resurrection. St. Paul speaks out to encourage the people.

Paul is someone who speaks to our age too. He is encouraging us not to be distracted in our modern world from the glory that Christ has won for us. Our attention can so easily be taken by the many novelties the world has to offer and our faith can be eroded by a variety of voices that speak to us of other philosophies and outlooks. Like the first followers of Jesus we need to be reminded of the truth that Christ died and rose again so that we may have life, the Resurrection is not a myth, it is an event of history. This is the central teaching of our faith, on this fact all else rests. May the Lord strengthen us in our faith and make of us a people who place Christ at the centre of our lives that we may bring this truth to others and be a source of hope for all.
