Reflection: Our local town and county are united again in remembrance this weekend. We stand together on the common ground of our wounded humanity. Among other things, we ask God for relief for those who still suffer; we ask for healing of hearts broken in loss; and we ask for God's sustaining blessing on our sense of being one community. May God's light grow brighter in us all.

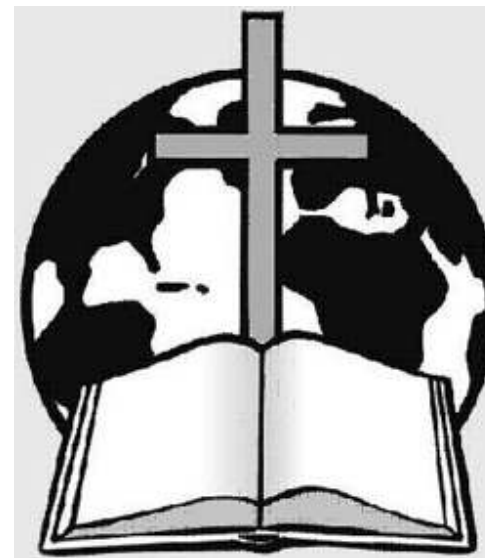
