Prior of Lough Derg is named Monsignor by Pope Francis

His Holiness Pope Francis has conferred the honour of Chaplain to His Holiness on Reverend Laurence (La) Flynn, priest of the Diocese of Clogher and Prior of Lough Derg, an honour which carries with it the title of Monsignor. The title Monsignor means that the priest has been made an honorary member of the Pope's own 'household'.



Announcing the appointment, the Bishop of Clogher, Bishop Larry Duffy, said he was very pleased to receive notification from the Holy See before Christmas. 'It is a well-merited honour for Fr Flynn and recognises his own significant contribution to the life and ministry of our diocese, of which Lough Derg is an important part. This appointment also signifies a close connection between the Holy Father and the mission of Lough Derg in today's world. That mission, continuing in the tradition that goes back to St Patrick, is to be a sacred space and a place on the margins where people can find the God of love and compassion'

We wish Monsignor Flynn every blessing and consolation in his continued priestly service to us in the Diocese of Clogher, particularly now at Lough Derg as he leads the Island team in charting a pilgrimage path for the future.
