Reflection: On June 12th we celebrated the feast of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The origin of this devotion in its modern form came from a French nun, Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, who said she learned the devotion from Jesus during a series of apparitions. In the first apparition Jesus said: "My Divine Heart. is so inflamed with love for humanity, that, being unable any longer to contain within Itself the flames of Its burning Charity, It must needs spread them abroad in order to enrich humanity with the precious treasures which contain graces of sanctification and salvation". In the revelations of the Sacred Heart, Christ wanted all people to know the love we are held in by God so that we could leave aside anything unworthy of God from our lives and fully rejoice in the love of God. In order to do this properly we must be open to conversion to Jesus each day and strive to be more loving to those we meet. The greatest commandment Christ gave is that *"we should love one another"*. Christ has no body now but ours. If His love is to be made real in the world it is up to us who claim to be Christian, not to others, to make it so.
