**Reflection:** Today marks the Feast of Pentecost and the beginning of the third week of May. Here, we find Mary at the heart of the infant church. She had heard from the apostles how the Ascending Jesus encouraged them to return to Jerusalem, and to gather in prayer with her, waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit. She, more than the apostles, knew what it was to receive the gift of the spirit.... memory brought her back to her annunciation day, to the wonder of God's promise, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you". She knew what it was for her life to be enveloped by God, that out of fear and confusion God could bring hope and blessing. Now, at Pentecost, she invites the Church and ourselves to place our worries and hopes in the care of the Holy Spirit. We can pray, as she did, with the words of Psalm 57 "In the shadow of your wings I take refuge, till the storms of destruction pass by". We can turn to the Circling prayer of our own Celtic tradition, "Circle me, O Lord. Keep peace within. Keep fear without. Circle me, O Lord."
