## Reflection ~ What do we learn from the Canaanite woman?

There are a number of lessons from today's Gospel. Firstly, the need for total trust  
and confidence that Jesus really does care for us.

There is also the need for us to persist in prayer. We must realise that this does not  
always result in getting what we have asked for. It helps us to see more clearly what  
God wants for us and what really is the best for us - for us to be able to say, I want  
what He wants.

Thirdly, today's Gospel is an affirmation that God's love and mercy are extended to  
all who call on Him in faith and trust, no matter who they are or where they are.  
As baptised members of the Christian community, we have been given special  
privileges of knowledge and access to God's love. But we have also serious  
responsibilities arising from this. One of these responsibilities is to make clear to  
others by the way we live, speak and act that God's love and God's mercy and God's  
healing are for them also. *(Frank Doyle, S.J.)*
