Reflection:

In this 'Year of Faith' we are being challenged to look again at the call to salvation we have received from God in Christ and to ask ourselves how we might become more open to the power of faith within ourselves and within our communities. By virtue of our Baptism we have all received the vocation of proclaiming God's word. This time, dedicated to celebrating the gift of faith, provides us with plenty of opportunities to stop and consider how well we have given voice to Christ. It is good for us to ask how we might better be the people, the evangelisers, Jesus asks us to be. Do we take our faith, and all it calls us to be, seriously enough?

Do we need to do more to help foster our own faith and belief in others?

Do we trust that Christ can use us to be His living voice in our world?

Maybe a good place for us to begin this inward searching is to look at what St. Paul says to us, just as he said it to the people of Corinth in Sundays second reading.

God has given all of us gifts and called all of us to a variety of services.

Do we have confidence in the gifts the Holy Spirit has given us?

Are we willing to trust God and have confidence in the trust God places in us?

May this Year of Faith be a time when each of us is renewed in our own faith that we may renew others in theirs thus helping our world know more powerfully the presence of God among and the truth that Christ is Lord.
