Reflection

Today marks the feast of the Most Holy Trinity and the fourth Sunday in May. The Trinity can seem a difficult idea for us, far removed from our ordinary lives, yet in Mary's company we begin to see it as a network of warm personal relationships. Her annunciation was a message from God the Father, she is to become the mother of Jesus, the Holy Spirit will come upon her and help her. Mary would share in the life of the Holy Trinity, just as we too were called at our baptism...we were and are baptised in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Like Mary, our relationships with all three will deepen as we ponder the mystery within, allowing the words of today's second reading to speak to us. "The love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us". May the words of a Russian mystic help us welcome the Trinity within.
