No Mow May It's nearly the time of year when we are asked to lock away the lawnmowers! #NoMowMay is an annual campaign asking you to not mow your lawn during the month of May to help our native wildlife. On the island of Ireland, one third of our wild bees are threaten with extinction. This is mainly because of hunger - there isn't enough food to support them in our landscape. Taking part in **No Mow May** couldn't be easier - just put away the lawnmower for May and wait and see what grows. You might be surprised by what appears over a short few weeks.. You may see plants like dandelions, red and white clover, and bird-foot trefoil, which are all excellent sources of food for pollinating insects.
