## Reflection ~ Year of Faith October 2012 – November 2013

This year we celebrate two very significant anniversaries in the history of the Catholic Church. This date marks the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council in Rome and also the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the publication of the latest addition of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. **The theme for this year of faith is that the door of faith is always open to us.** Ushering us into the life of Communion of God and offering entry into his Church. Pope Benedict Emeritus expressed his hope that this year would lead people out of the wilderness in which they so often found themselves and 'towards the place of life, towards friendship with the Son of God, towards the one who gives life and life in abundance'. In his apostolic letter *Porta Fidei*, he says 'Faith grows when it is lived as an experience of love received and when it is communicated as an experience of grace and joy. It makes us fruitful because it expands our hearts in hope and enables us to bear life-giving witness: indeed, it opens the hearts and minds of those who listen to respond to the Lord's invitation, to adhere to his word and become his disciples'
