Reflection : Fr John Sullivan S.J. was born in 1861 into a wealthy Protestant Church of Ireland family in Dublin. He was a son of the Lord Chancellor of Ireland. He studied in Portora, Enniskillen (1873-79) and Trinity College and practiced as a lawyer in the English bar. He was known as 'the best dressed man in Dublin.' In his mid-thirties John Sullivan became a Catholic. Two years later in 1890 he entered the Jesuits, was ordained in 1907 in Milltown Park and spent the rest of his life as a teacher and spiritual director to the students in Clongowes Wood college in County Kildare. There he became known as a poorly dressed man of prayer and penance with a gift of healing. He travelled all around the countryside visiting the sick. He died in 1933 aged seventy-two years. His simple life-style invites us to look beyond ourselves as the centre of attention, to be interested in the well-being of others, and to discover, as people have in every century, the spiritual dimension that lifts one's life out of the traffic that tends to smother with noise and fog the flowering of the Spirit. All who met John Sullivan sensed his goodness and felt touched and uplifted by it. People continue to pray at his shrine in Gardiner Street church in Dublin. There is a process under way in Rome to have him beatified, that is declared 'Blessed.'
