We had a wonderful Ordination last Sunday afternoon at which Deacon Martin was ordained by Bishop Alan McGuckian, who was Deacon Martin's first Director of Formation on his three-year training course. Similarly for the Evening Prayer at which Deacon Martin presided on the following evening. High compliments were paid by the clergy, the guests and the parishioners present to the beauty, the prayerfulness and the good ordering of both services. Thanks to our Diocesan Liturgy Commission and the group they formed to oversee the arrangements: Mary McDaid, Eileen Gallagher, Gary Carville (Diocesan Communications Officer) and, most of all to Father Raymond & team for their meticulous work. The Parish Choirs excelled themselves and made a wonderful sound for both liturgies. We must highly compliment the Choir Directors - Sharon Kelly and Paul Flynn - and the Organists - Caecilia Bastien and Mary Keenan - for their achievement. They were a credit to the parish. There was also a strong representation from our Church of Ireland neighbours: Bishop John McDowell, Dean Kenny Hall and Mr Glenn Moore (Diocesan Secretary). The church is looking particularly well these days, having benefited from a significant amount of work over recent years in relation to the mosaic, the upgraded lighting throughout, and, just recently, the deep cleaning of the seats, the floors, the marble and the stone. Compliments must be paid to Mullarkey-Pedersen Architects, Kevin Corrigan, Builder, and others involved. The flower arrangements (by Mary Keenan, Mary Magee and Mary Keenan) were particularly beautiful. Bishop Liam MacDaid was present, who accepted Deacon Martin as a Candidate for the Diocese some four years ago. We congratulate Deacon Martin himself on the dedicated application and hard work that brought him to this day, and also his wife, Cáit, their daughter Ciara (together with husband Cathal and baby Lorcan), and their son Brian (together with wife Ruth). We join with Martin in these historic days where he ministers among us as a Deacon of the Diocese, in this reincarnation of the ancient & venerable ministry. *We wish him many happy years in the service of the Lord and his people.*
