Reflection

The doctrine of the Holy Trinity, that God is three persons in one Supreme Being, is a great mystery of our faith. We live in an age that can often struggle with the notion of mystery, but that we do not understand something does not mean it cannot be true. The doctrine of the Trinity is well founded in the Sacred Scriptures. Jesus, Himself, makes reference to the Father, to He and the Father being One, and to the Advocate, the Holy Spirit. The Trinity teaches us a great truth which is that in Jesus Christ we receive the fullness of God's grace. God holds nothing of His own personhood and reality back from us but gives of Himself fully and freely that we may possess life in Him. Let us thank God for this gift and give praise as we pray:

O most holy Trinity, Almighty God, we adore You, who give life and vigour to every creature and who shed light eternal where there is darkness. We offer you our hearts, our souls, and our whole being, today and in the days to come, that we may offer perfect praise and love to the glorious Name of God, Three in One, Father, Son & Holy Spirit.
