Reflection:

Using the five fingers to Pray - by Pope Francis

1. The thumb is the closest finger to you so start by praying for those closest to you.
 2. The next finger is the index. Pray for those who teach you, instruct you and heal you.
 3. The following finger is the tallest. It reminds us of our leaders and those who have authority. They need God's guidance.
 4. The fourth finger is the ring finger and it may surprise you that it is the weakest finger. It should remind us to pray for the weakest, the sick or those plagued by problems. They need your prayers.
 5. Finally, we have our smallest finger. The pinkie should remind you to pray for yourself and your own needs after you have prayed for the others.
