Reflection: Our Gospel passage this weekend uses the image of Bartimaeus, the blind man, to remind us that we are called to be a people of vision, a people who truly see who Jesus is. We are being given a call to faith in the one who is to save us. We begin also this weekend our 1st Holy Communion programme, 'Do This in Memory'. The young people and their families who are taking part in this programme are echoing the call pronounced in the Gospel of the 'blind beggar'. They too, simply by preparing for 1st Holy Communion, are reminding us of who it is who comes to meet us in the Holy Eucharist. These young people are calling us to a deeper faith in Jesus. They are challenging us to be a people of vision, a people who truly see who it is we are meeting at the Altar of God as we gather together in worship and as we come forward to receive the Blessed Sacrament. They are calling us to salvation. Let us answer that call in a spirit of faith, of hope and of joy, recognising our Saviour and all we receive in and from Christ. Let us pray too, for all those preparing to join us at the Lord's banqueting table. With us, may they always 'see' the truth of who Jesus is and have faith.
