Reflection

Today marks the feast of Corpus Christi, and the final Sunday in May. If anyone can help us appreciate this great mystery it is surely Mary. Caryll Houselander captures the intimacy of her mothering of Jesus: "For nine months Christ grew in His mother's body,... working, eating, sleeping, she was forming his body from hers....walking in the streets of Nazareth to do her shopping, she set his feet on the path of Jerusalem,...every beat of her heart gave him his heart to love with, his heart to be broken by love....breaking and eating bread, drinking the wine of the country, she gave him his flesh and blood; she prepared the host for the Mass".

How special it must have been for her, in later life, to receive the Son whom she had loved and nurtured! We could invite her to be with us as we enter into the Mass and receive Holy Communion. She throws light on Teresa of Avila's prayer:

"Christ has no body now on earth but ours.

No hands, no feet but ours.

Ours are the eyes through which he looks compassionate and kind.

Christ has no body now on earth but ours".
