The Season of Creation Sept 1st - Oct 14th As we prepare to enter the Season of Creation, Pope Leo XIV offers us a powerful Message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. This year, as we follow the theme Living Water, his words feel especially meaningful. Scripture reminds us to guard our hearts, because from them flows everything we do (Prov 4:23). What is flowing from my heart into the world? Is it care or indifference? Hope or discouragement? A desire for justice, peace and communion? Pope Leo reminds us that ecological conversion begins within us - but it is meant to flow outward, transforming how we live, how we relate to others and how we care for our common home. 		Planning a Baptism When presenting a child for Baptism, parents are encouraged to contact the Parish Office in good time so that the preparation process can be explained and any questions answered. The Church asks that a child have either one sponsor (Godparent) or, where two sponsors are chosen, one male and one female sponsor. Sponsors should normally be practising Catholics, at least 16 years of age, who have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, and who are willing to support the child in the practice of the faith. Where this is not possible, we will be happy to explain the role of a Christian witness. Please speak to the Parish Office, who will be happy to advise.
